

Ministry Intern

The Ministry Internship Program is a one-year paid opportunity open to men and women who are interested in gaining real ministry experience in the context of a local church. This program is primarily designed for individuals who are in their last two years of college or who are at a similar age and stage of life. Interns will work in a specific ministry department, gaining valuable training, mentorship, and leadership development. Depending on ministry needs, a second-year extension may be available.

Department: Residency (serving in several possible ministry departments)

Hours: Part-time working up to 20 hours per week

Duration: 12-24 months

Timeframe: August through July

Ministry Areas:

- College and Young Adults – Engage with college students and young adults through discipleship, outreach, and events.
- Students (6th-12th graders) – Lead and mentor students, organizing youth programs and fostering spiritual growth.
- Worship – Assist in planning worship services, supporting worship teams, and developing worship experiences.

Responsibilities:

- Engage in ministry leadership, discipleship, and service within assigned departments.
- Assist in planning and executing programs, events, and worship services.
- Build relationships with ministry participants through mentoring and small group leadership.
- Participate in staff meetings, training sessions, and other HHBC initiatives.
- Support ministry leaders with administrative and logistical tasks.
- Model a Christ-centered life and demonstrate a commitment to spiritual growth.

Qualifications:

- A believer and follower of Jesus Christ with a passion for ministry.
- Currently in last two years of college or at a similar age and/or stage of life.
- A humble and teachable attitude, strong work ethic, and a heart for serving others.
- Strong relational and communication skills.
- Ability to work well in a team and take initiative in ministry responsibilities.
- Willingness to be flexible and adaptable to different ministry needs.
