

## Ministry Resident

The Ministry Residency Program is designed to provide hands-on ministry experience, spiritual growth, and leadership development for individuals exploring a calling to vocational ministry. Ministry Residents will serve in a specific ministry area while receiving mentorship, training, and theological development. This residency is a support-raised position, and residents will partner with Reliant Mission in order to receive training, coaching, and accountability in raising and maintaining financial support.

**Department:** Residency

**Hours:** 40 hours weekly

**Duration:** 24 months

**Ministry Areas:** *(Ministry Residents will serve in one of the following areas based on their calling, skills, and ministry needs)*

- College and Young Adult – Engage with college students and young adults through outreach, discipleship, and various events.
- Students (6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders) – Lead and mentor students and organize programs and events fostering spiritual growth in the next generation.
- Worship – Assist in planning and leading worship services, developing worship teams, and enhancing HHBC's worship culture.

### Responsibilities:

- Engage in ministry leadership, discipleship, and teaching within the assigned ministry area.
- Assist in planning and executing events, programs, and worship services.
- Build relationships with ministry participants through one-on-one mentoring and small group leadership.
- Collaborate with ministry leaders and staff to further HHBC's mission and vision.
- Participate in regular study, training, coaching, and spiritual development sessions.
- Raise financial support in partnership with Reliant and steward relationships with ministry partners.
- Serve as a committed HHBC member, modeling a Christ-centered life.

### Qualifications:

- A believer and follower of Jesus Christ with a growing spiritual life.
- A passion for ministry and a desire to explore vocational ministry calling and opportunities.
- A teachable and humble attitude, eager to grow in leadership and faith.
- Strong relational and communication skills.
- Ability to work well in a team and take initiative in ministry responsibilities.
- Willingness to participate in the support-raising process with Reliant's training and guidance.
